1. Student is not to have contact with targeted student in any way. Student is not to speak to targeted student, interact with targeted student, make derogatory, insulting or threatening remarks in the targeted student's presence, display any insulting gestures, contact or reference targeted student using social media or engage or direct other students to harass or bully targeted student. Student is not to intimidate, bully or harass targeted student in any capacity.
<ul> <li>2. If bullying occurred prior to the start of the school day, when student arrives in the building, he/she will report immediately to the main office. Student will not leave main office until the assigned adult escort arrives. Mr./Mrs will serve as the adult escort ( initials)</li> </ul>
3. Mr./Mrs, the classroom teacher, will keep the targeted student and the student engaged in bullying/harassing behavior separated in the classroom and during class activities. Any and all incidents of harassment/bullying/intimidation/retaliation will immediately be addressed and then reported to the designated bullying investigator. If target and student engaged in bullying/harassing behavior have multiple classes together, all teaching staff associated with the class will be added onto a separate, attached sheet and given the same responsibility to separate the students, address any problematic behavior an report immediately ( initials)
4. Classroom teachers will keep the targeted student and the student engaged in bullying/harassing behavior separated in the classroom and during class activities. Teachers wi immediately intervene, address and report any and all incidents of harassment/ bullying/ intimidation/ retaliation to the designated bullying investigator ( initials)
<ul> <li>5. If bullying/harassing behavior occurred during passing periods, student engaged in bullying/harassing behavior is now on delayed passing until the safety plan expires. Mr./Mrs.</li> <li> will escort the student engaged in bullying/harassing behavior from class to class. Student will not exit the class until the adult escort has arrived. Any bullying</li> </ul>

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	ntimidation, narassment and/or retailation will be addressed immediately and reported to he administration as soon as possible.			
	Appropriate staff will be advised of the student safety plan, visible in the hallways and nonitoring the student engaged in bullying/harassing behavior at all times. Any bullying, ntimidation, harassment and/or retaliation will be addressed immediately and reported to he administration as soon as possible ( initials)			
	If bullying/harassing behavior occurred during recess, Mr./Mrs is lesignated as the student's recess monitor and will be visible and vigilantly monitoring student' onduct during recess. Any bullying, intimidation, harassment and/or retaliation will be ddressed immediately and reported to the administration as soon as possible initials)			
	I. If bullying/harassing behavior occurred during lunch, Mr./Mrs is lesignated as the student's lunch monitor and will be visible and vigilantly monitoring student's onduct during lunch. Any bullying, intimidation, harassment and/or retaliation will be ddressed immediately and reported to the administration as soon as possible initials)			
	9. If bullying/harassing behavior occurred during physical education class or in the locker room before or after physical education class, Mr./Mrs is designated as the student's Gym class monitor and will be visible and vigilantly monitoring student's conduct during Gym class and before or after Gym class in the locker room. Any bullying, intimidation, harassment and/or retaliation will be addressed immediately and reported to the administration as soon as possible (initials)			
	O. If bullying/harassing behavior occurred during extra-curricular activities, including athletics, Mr./Mrs is designated as the extra-curricular monitor and will be visible and vailable during extra-curricular activities. Any bullying, intimidation, harassment and/or etaliation will be addressed immediately and reported to the administration as soon as possible (initials)			
	1. If bullying/harassing behavior occurred on the bus either before or after school, student will have an assigned seat on the bus, closest to the bus driver. The bus driver will be instructed to eparate the student engaged in bullying/harassing behavior and the targeted student, intervene immediately and to report any bus incidents immediately to either the building principal or dispatch, who will then report the incidents to the building principal. Any bullying, intimidation, harassment and/or retaliation will be addressed immediately and reported to the administration as soon as possible (initials)			
	3. If the student walks home and has engaged in bullying/harassing behavior on the way home tudent will receive a 15-minute after-school detention until the plan expires(initials)			
	4. The school will immediately report any incidents of bullying, harassment, intimidation nd/or retaliation to the student's parents/legal guardians (initials)
