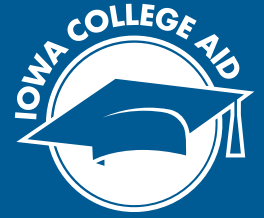


# 2018–19 State Scholarship & Grant Quick Reference Guide

The Quick Guide provides a brief overview of the general student eligibility criteria for state scholarship and grant programs as well as general processing guidelines.



## All Iowa Opportunity Scholarship

Students with financial need who graduated from an Iowa high school.

- FAFSA and Iowa Financial Aid Application due March 1.
  - Priority given to students in foster care, children of deceased public safety workers, TRIO, alternative high schools/alternative programs, and GEAR UP students.
- EFC at or below \$9,064.
- Must attend within two years of graduating high school.
- Enroll in 3 or more semester hours (or equivalent).
- Maximum award – \$4,532.

## GEAR UP Iowa Scholarship

Students who participated in the 2.0 GEAR UP Iowa program.

- FAFSA required.
- Enroll in 3 or more semester hours (or equivalent).
- Maximum award – \$1,200.

## Education Training Voucher

Students who age out of foster care or were previously in foster care and legally adopted after age 16.

- FAFSA and Iowa Financial Aid Application due December 1.
- Enroll in 3 or more semester hours (or equivalent).
- Maximum award – \$5,000.

## Iowa National Guard Education Assistance Program

Students who are members of the Iowa National Guard or Air National Guard.

- FAFSA and Iowa Financial Aid Application required.
- Priority Deadline:
  - Fall Deadline – July 1.
  - Spring Deadline – December 1.
- Maximum award – \$7,725

## Iowa Tuition Grant – Not for Profit

Students who attend a non-profit private university.

- FAFSA required – due July 1.
- EFC at or below \$13,500.
- Enroll in 3 or more semester hours (or equivalent).
- Maximum award – \$5,650.

## Iowa Tuition Grant – For Profit

Students who attend a for profit or an eligible barber and cosmetology institution.

- FAFSA required – due July 1.
- EFC at or below \$13,000.
- Maximum award, Waldorf – \$2,150.
- Maximum award, barber and cosmetology schools – \$2,150.

## Iowa Vocational-Technical Tuition Grant

Students enrolled in career and technical education programs at community colleges.

- FAFSA required – due July 1.
- Enroll in 3 or more semester hours (or equivalent).
- EFC range of \$201 to \$5,300.
- Maximum award – \$900.
  - Award on a sliding scale based on EFC.

## Kibbie Grant

Students enrolled in specified career and technical education programs at community colleges.

- FAFSA required – due July 1.
- Enroll in 3 or more semester hours (or equivalent).
- EFC at or below \$6,000.
- Maximum award – \$2,700.
  - Award on a sliding scale based on EFC.
